- Om du studerat på högskola/universitet bifogar du även ett betygsutdrag på engelska för dessa studier.

- Citizenship: Kryssa "No visa".
- Ethnicity: I de flesta fall alternativ W: *White Non-Hispanic*.
- **På bladet "Financial Statement"** räcker det med att ange CSN som sponsor på raden "Sponsor's name in full". Beloppet som ska fyllas i under "First year funding" är 24.989 USD.
